There are no potable water hookups in the park. There is non-potable water at the dump station and potable water is available at the restrooms (by the airport parking area). Campers may use the showers located in the restrooms. All fees must be paid, either in person to Village Hall (1233 Charlotte St. across the street from the campground) or by placing payment in the drop box on the west side of Village Hall, prior to setting up camp. Restrooms and dump site close after Oct 15th each year. Stays over 31 days in a season must be approved by the board.

Failure to pay fees may result in your arrest for Fraud on Innkeeper Wisc. Stat. 943.21(1m)(b), which is punishable by up to a \$10,000 fine and/or 9 months confinement.

Park Rules

1. No dumping of gray or black water on the ground.
2. No fireworks.
3. Keep your area, shelter, and bathrooms neat and clean.
4. Keep campfires inside of the ring (clean wood only).
5. Dogs or other domesticated animals must be on a leash no longer than 8 feet and under the owner's control. Radio collars are not allowed. Do not leave pets unattended outdoors.
6. Animal waste must be cleaned up immediately and disposed of properly. Owners must provide their own bags, scoops, or other needed tools.
7. All dogs must be licensed and tagged properly. Pit Bulls or Pit Bull type dogs are prohibited. No dogs on monthly stays except small lap dogs.
8. Quiet hours are 10 PM to 8 AM.
9. It is unlawful for any sex offender to be physically present within the park boundaries or to loiter within 150 feet of the park.
10. No more than 2 vehicles per camp site and must be legally parked.
11. Minors must be supervised at all times.
12. Follow all other Village and State laws and orders from village staff.

Violations of park rules will result in a fee of \$25 for the first offense, \$50 for the second offense, and removal and forfeiture of camping fees on the third offense. Removal may occur on the first or second violation if Village staff deems the behavior unsafe.
